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Sub: Grant of yearly Permission to Allama Iqbal Unani Medical College and ACN Hospital, Muzaffarnagar, Roorkee Road, Near Satsang Bhawan, Muzaffarnagar-251002 Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0308) with 42 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kulliyat-e-Umoore Tabiya-05 seats and (ii) Tahaffuzzi wa Samaji Tib-05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Allama Iqbal Unani Medical College and ACN Hospital, Muzaffarnagar, Roorkee Road, Near Satsang Bhawan, Muzaffarnagar-251002, Uttar Pradesh** inspection was conducted on **27.06.2025 & 28.06.2025 via Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **annual visitation for issuance of permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kulliyat-e-Umoore Tabiya-05 seats and (ii) Tahaffuzzi wa Samaji Tib-05 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", and Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the Visitor Observation following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**
 1. **Biometric attendance**
 - a) **On verification with AEBAS team,** It came to notice that the college has initiated the process of marking attendance but no any single teacher has been registered in the AEBAS portal for the aforementioned college till 24.07.2025.
 2. **Teaching staffs:-**
 - a) **Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BUMS). Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is** $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{28}{30} \times 100\% = 93.33\%$ (Excluding Excess).
 - b) **Shortcomings for UG are as under-**

- 3) Thereafter, the assessment report was duly placed in the **144th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 27.08.2025 and the Board discussed and decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to college for the remaining shortcoming.**
- 4) Accordingly, an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 30.08.2025** was provided to you to appear on **02.09.2025** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the permission to your college for the academic session 2025-26 be denied.**
- 5) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter. ref. 204/AIUMC/2025 dated 01.09.2025 against the deficiencies conveyed to college.** Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Prof. Mushtaque Hussain, Principal/Nodal Officer-AEBAS & Prof. Muzaffar Hussain, Vice Principal of the college** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **02.09.2025** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The submission made by the representatives of the college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

Subsequently, on 11.04.2025, the college again Completed the manage On boarding form Registration, after which the NCISM Provided us the Login ID and Password. (Encl-4, A to D)</p> <p>3. Thereafter, On 19.05.2025, after receiving the Login ID and Password, the college once again approached M/S Mantra Softech Pvt. Therefore, Due to above factors AEBAS Biometric Machine installation could not be completed in time and the College, In order to maintain full compliance, has been sincerely Marking the attendance of Teaching staff and Other staff through Manual and by Default Fingerprint-based Biometric Attendance System Machine.(Encl-9, A to E)</p> <p>8. During the Surprise Inspection by the NCISM Visitor Team conducted on 27.06.2025 and 28.06.2025, all the above facts and documentary evidence were humbly placed before them and were duly verified by the Team. (Encl-10)</p> <p>We assure our continued commitment to comply with all the directives, regulations and guidelines of MARBISM and NCISM in letter and spirit. The necessary installation is already Underway, and the Portal will be duly updated immediately upon its Completion. We further undertake to strictly adhere to all regulatory instructions in the future as well. In view of the above, we most respectfully request your kind consideration of our present circumstances and grant the permission for academic session 2025-26.</p>	<p>considerable as the technical issue can be faced after the installation of the machine only. The Nodal officer has not registered himself and machine on NCISM portal, till date. Activation code has not been generated by the nodal officer till date.</p> <p>The submission given by the college cannot be accepted. Therefore, the shortcoming still persists.</p>
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- 6) Accordingly, AEBAS report from the date on which login credentials were provided to you, till the date prior to **145th** Board meeting of MARB-ISM is as under:

- 7) Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing, College's AEBAS report and the assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", and relevant regulations thereunder and the recommendation of Hearing Committee was duly placed before the **145th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 02.09.2025 and Board decided that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations.**
- 8) **However, the Board decided to issue Permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28(1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 as the college has not followed the AEBAS guidelines as mentioned in Implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS and HMS dated 09.05.2024 and ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS and HMS dated 06.09.2024.**

As per the Penalization Policy adopted in accordance of Section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act 2020 for Non/Improper/Delayed Implementation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) in ASU College for the Academic year 2025-26:-

- a) "In cases of delayed or improper implementation of the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS), the college shall subject to seat reduction by reducing 30% intake strength of total intake capacity."


Therefore, for seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 30% of total intake capacity.

- 9) Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2025-26 under section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act 2020 for **Non/Improper/Delayed Implementation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) in ASU Colleges for the Academic year 2025-26**, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Yearly Permission with 42 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kulliyat-e-Umoore Tabiya-05 seats and (ii) Tahaffuzzi wa Samaji Tib-05 seats in accordance with Regulation 16 (2) & (3) (h) of MESAR UG Unani 2023 & Regulation 16 (8) (g) of MESAR PG Unani, 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 23.01.2025.

"DECISION"

- 10) **Therefore, Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Allama Iqbal Unani Medical College and ACN Hospital, Muzaffarnagar, Roorkee Road, Near Satsang Bhawan, Muzaffarnagar-251002 Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0308) with 42 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kulliyat-e-Umoore Tabiya-05 seats and (ii) Tahaffuzzi wa Samaji Tib-05 seats in accordance with 16 (2) & 16 (3)(h) of MESAR UG (Unani) 2023 & as per the approved seats reduction policy under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and subject to the condition that the following requirements shall be fulfilled: -**
- I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 42 seats (instead of 60 seats) and 10 seats in 02 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 11) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 12) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 13) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 14) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters with vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 15) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB-ISM by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
- iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for the Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
- v) Shortcoming under Para 2.

- 16) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
- 17) **In case, if you are not satisfied with the above decision you may prefer 1st appeal to the Chairman/Secretary, NCISM as per relevant rules & regulations thereunder.**
- 18) **Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.**
